

PERMISSION SLIP – Nantucket Island Bicycle Trip 2011 - Sept 30 – Oct 2

EVENT: Bicycle / Camping Trip (2 nights)

LOCATION: Nantucket Island, BSA Camp Richard (<http://www.camprichard.org>)

Activities: Bike touring, swimming, sports activities, Camp Richard rec room, etc.

MEET: Friday, September 30 @ 6:30am, UCC parking lot (Do NOT be late or you're on your own for transportation!) **Bring bag lunch** in your day pack to eat on ferry or after arriving at camp.**

RETURN: Sunday October 2, approx 3:30pm, UCC parking lot

COSTS: \$50 per person, includes ferry charges per person and per bicycle, also cost of troop food.

UNIFORM: Class-B.

MEALS PROVIDED: Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast, lunch & dinner. Sunday breakfast.

Bring Saturday bag lunch in your day pack to eat on ferry or after arriving at Camp.**

BRING: Bicycle in top form*, helmet that fits correctly – not loose, bike lock, sleeping bag, pad, mess kit, filled water bottle mounted on bicycle, flashlight, sunscreen, bug repellent, hat, extra clothes, coat/jacket, rain gear (NO ponchos), bathing suit, towel, toiletry kit, sunglasses, small day-pack or fanny pack, money (for souvenirs, meals in town, etc), Scout Handbook, Scout Spirit. Note: Troop will supply tents.

***IMPORTANT:** Make sure your bicycle is in top form: properly inflated tires, correctly adjusted brakes, working gear shifters that do not derail the chain, handle bar tight. If you are unsure of whether your bike meets these requirements or how to do perform these adjustments, get your bike to a repair shop for a tuneup ASAP. Check out your bike immediately. Do not dust it off that morning!
